Shalom's Vision

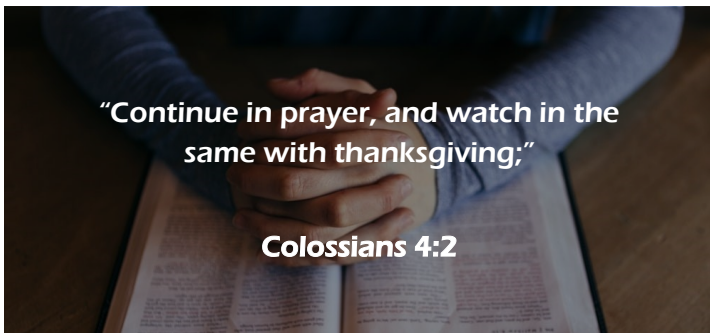
